Re: 2010 Senior Incentive **REVISED AND FINAL** Field Trip Information

As an update to previously announced information, the Senior Incentive Field Trip for this year has been moved to Houston, Texas. The trip is still scheduled for **March 17-20, 2010** (Wednesday – Saturday) and all information remains consistent besides the trip location and agenda. **48 seniors and 5 advisor chaperones** from the NM MESA Programs statewide will be selected from the applications received to participate.

Please note that nearly everything for this event will be distributed, submitted, and or is available electronically so it is **EXTREMELY** important that you understand the current procedures for applying to attend this amazing field trip.

STUDENT INFORMATION:

- Student Applications are due **Friday, December 4th at 5:00 PM MST**. A complete application includes online application completion (including essay upload) and submittal of required grade reports to your Regional Coordinator. Required grade reports include a copy of the students' transcript, a copy of the most recent grade report, and any college transcripts or grade reports as needed for Math, Science, and/or English courses.
- Incomplete or late applications will **not be considered**.
- Applicants must be active NM MESA members in good standing during their Junior and Senior years to qualify.
- Each participant selected will be required to make a non-refundable deposit of \$450.00 to be collected in two installments. The first in January/February at the Regional SIFT Parent Meetings (TBA by each Regional Coordinator) and the second by March 1st, 2010.
- Students and Advisors will be notified of the selection results by December 28th, 2009 via email.
- Additional students who qualify will be placed on a statewide waiting list.

ADVISOR INFORMATION:

- All advisors interested in attending will also need to complete an online application by **Friday, December 4th at 5:00 PM MST**. A complete application includes online application completion and submittal of a letter of support/approval from a school administrator to your Regional Coordinator.
- 5 advisors will be chosen from the statewide program. Middle and High School advisors are encouraged to apply.
- Any school sending 5 or more students on the SIFT trip **WILL BE REQUIRED** to send a school/district chaperone. Failure to do so will result in some of your students from your school program being removed from the trip to be under the 5 student requirement. Please plan in advance to attend. If you have a large number of applying students, it is a good idea to prepare early to send someone and complete the application by the deadline. Otherwise this could result in some of your students not being initially selected if NM MESA cannot get an advisor commitment when needed.
- Each advisor selected as a Chaperone will be required to make a non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 to be collected in two installments. The first in January/February at the Regional NASA Parent Meetings (TBA by each Regional Coordinator) and the second by March 1st, 2010.
- Advisors will be notified of the selection results by December 28th, 2009 via email.

REGISTRATION PROCESS AND ONLINE EVENT SITE:

- Please visit the NM MESA Website: <http://nmmesa.org>; Advisor (or Student) Section, Events & Registration Link. This is the link to the event website and the registration area.
- Registration will need to be completed by EACH APPLICANT (student or advisor) creating (1) registration per applicant.
- On Line Registration will collect all needed information as follows:
 - Student Information:
 - All the information that is on the current A-4 Application in the Advisor Handbook.
 - Students will need to upload an electronic version of their required essay: “Why I want to attend the NM MESA Senior Incentive Field Trip”. This essay needs to be uploaded as either a Microsoft Office-Word or PDF document.
 - Students will need their advisors’ name and email as well as a current personal email. All correspondence will be sent via email. Make sure that all email accounts allow nmmesa.org emails, specifically the email of the Program Coordinator.
 - Students will need to know their correct NM MESA Region. Since slots are allocated regionally, this is EXTREMELY important. If you do not know, ask your Regional Coordinator.
 - Advisor Information:
 - Advisor application will collect basic contact data.
 - Questions will be asked questions pertaining to your recent MESA programs, recent non-MESA programs, and why you want to be a chaperone on the SIFT Trip.
- Once registered, each applicant will receive a confirmation email and number which will allow them to modify or cancel their registration up to the application deadline of December 4th, 2009. This email will also be sent to the advisor email given in the registration process. Modifying includes adding to or editing the registration information. Do not cancel a registration unless the applicant is withdrawing from the trip in entirety. An applicant that is unsure about applying SHOULD NOT register unless they are ENTIRELY SURE about applying.
- This email will also re-direct you to the event summary website which will contain all information needed for attendance including deadline reminders, current trip agenda, and more. The event summary website can also be accessed from the NM MESA website. This event website will become increasingly more important as EVERYTHING trip related will be posted here: final agendas, contact information, room lists, flight information, lodging information, parent information, etc.
